

# The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees

**March 13, 2006**

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday March 13, 2006 to transact business. Chairman Henning called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. James Danbury, Bari Henning and Jim Taylor answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson, Earl Whiteman, Matt Vansant and William Killen.

Mr. Taylor motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Mr. Danbury second. All yeas. Mr. Carson presented a financial report, including a comprehensive account of expenditures and receipts and the trustees accepted it.

### **Receipts of the meeting:**

Total Receipts: \$15,095.34

Mr. Danbury motioned to pay the following bills. Mr. Taylor second. All yeas.

Total Bills: \$59,388.33

Matt Vansant from the Clermont Chamber of Commerce said that he wanted to touch base to see how things are going and to say that now that he's back at the Chamber, he is here to help us. He said that the employment rate from 1998 to 2003 was 22-24%, which is very good. He said that our growth rate was one of the highest in the state. He gave a copy of the strategies for the Chamber over the next few years. He said that one major plan is in relationship building and that is why he's here. Mr. Danbury asked him about the TEL Tabor law that is being proposed for November. Mr. Vansant said that he is going to research the issue and the Chamber will probably be taking a stand on it. He said that they are working closely with the Clermont County Commissioners to work for the businesses and residents of Clermont County. Mr. Vansant said that the different committees such as the Chamber and County Economic Development and other county committees are all working together and relying on each other for the influence and specialties that each of them have. Mr. Danbury said that we have been caught in the middle of all of the different county committees and want to make sure we are getting the best help for the money we are investing. Mr. Killen said that they want to invite us back to the EDIC project at the Chamber.

### **Cemetery & Maintenance Report**

Mr. Whiteman said that we are scheduled to have township clean up days for June 8-10 and everything is scheduled with Rumpke. He said that all of the equipment is up and running. He said that they have done some ditching on some birm work along the roads. He said that there is a lot of construction taking place on Hibbs Road and the trucks are tearing up the road, but there is nothing that we can do, because the trucks are legal and the road is too narrow. He said that we have had a ton of rain recently and he's been watching all of the ditches and they are flowing OK.

Mr. Taylor motioned to endorse the Children's Services Levy on the May ballot. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.

Mr. Henning said that Cinery sent a letter saying that they are reconstructing electric lines along St. Rt. 276 from St. Rt. 133 towards Sharps Cutoff Road.

Mr. Danbury motioned to adopt a resolution to approve the solid waste plan dated 2004-2022 as proposed by Adams-Clermont Solid Waste Management District. Mr. Taylor second. All yeas.

Mr. Taylor motioned to adjourn at approximately 9:00 p.m. Mr. Danbury second. All yeas.
